

MAYACAMAS



2014 CHARDONNAY – MT. VEEDER, NAPA VALLEY

High on the slopes of Mount Veeder, Mayacamas Vineyards has been a source of legendary California wine since 1889. Since the 1950's the vinification and élevage of Mayacamas remains remarkably consistent and our continued commitment to employ classical techniques and tools is integral to the character of these wines. The mountain terroir at Mayacamas ranges from 1,800 to 2,400 feet in elevation and the estate spans 475 acres, only 50 of which are dedicated to vine.

VARIETAL: 100% Chardonnay
ALCOHOL: 14 1/2%

TASTING NOTES & WINEMAKING

Highly aromatic with notes of citrus, apple, and pear. The wine is well-balanced with a crisp acidity and a smooth finish. The winemaking process involves traditional techniques, including barrel aging, to enhance the wine's complexity and depth.

VINTAGE, VINEYARDS & TERROIR

The 2014 vintage was exceptional, characterized by a warm growing season and a long, dry harvest. The vines were healthy and produced a high-quality crop. The terroir of Mount Veeder, with its unique soil composition and elevation, plays a significant role in the wine's character.
